Syllabus

The aim of "Criminal Law (Crime Classification)" is to acquire knowledge of the crimes covered in the Spanish Penal Code, from the aspects of reality and of the Code's legal implementation, by studying the intervention of the main legal practitioners.

The course aims to analyse all aspects of criminal proceedings, from the points of view of the judge, the public prosecutor's office, the police and expert witnesses, etc, in order to learn about the characteristics of the major crimes in the PC and to be able to identify them in practice. At the same time, students acquire an understanding of the work that can be done by criminologists within the criminal justice system in relation to the different crimes that exist today.
